## Illustrations

The designs illustrate the iconic structures of Bombay's Gothic Architecture which went on to become the city's Identity. Characterized by the Indian craftsman's preference to elaboration, the Gothic style in the city became richer in detail which makes it unique and exclusive to Bombay.

"Kala Ghoda Kaleidoscope" celebrates the onset of Neo Gothic Architecture and showcases the transition and development of the city to a more exuberant language.

"Victorian Gothic Ensemble" is an ode to the World Heritage site of Mumbai overlooking the Oval Maidan, the front which was created as an expression of the most handsome structures overlooking the sea.

"Urbs Prima in Indis" as the name suggests depict the High Gothic dream of Bombay in the late 19<sup>th</sup> century. Named after the statue perched atop the gable top on the BMC building overlooking the Victoria Terminus establishes Bombay as the first city in the country.

"The Gateway to India" is evocative of the architectural shift which started changing the cityscape of Bombay from spires to minarets, pointed arches to cusped arches, vaulted ceilings and mansard roofs to domes and the city welcomed the 'Indo Saracenic' architectural style evident in the Gateway of India, the Taj Mahal Palace hotel, the Prince of wales Museum etc.,

The term "Bombay Bohemian" describes a particular style of art and culture characterized by freedom, creativity, and individuality, which resonate with the city's architectural history and lends a creative expression which is unique to Bombay. Bombay's story has been a love affair of the land and the sea. There's nothing quite like a fragrance to transport you to another time.. a time when Bombay was a group of seven islands and the first meeting of the rain laden clouds touching the land, filling the atmosphere with a mild perfume... to the time when Bombay transformed as the "Urbs Prima in Indis", and yet the surging and the lashing sea continued to touch the shores with a hazy mist of saltwater spray, mingling with the air, creating a distinct and unique smell, the smell which resonates with the city.

The two fragrances from the Bombay Gothic Collection, are inspired by these scents which encapsulate the essence of this city.

**Tides of time** - This alluring scent with notes of orange, eucalyptus, clove leaf and sea salt, is an exceptionally delicate smell, but at the same time it is immense and unique which is a blend of both, of evanescence and substance, although slight and frail, and yet solid and sustaining immediately resonating with the history and story of the city.

**Bom 'Bahia'** - In the moment when raindrops kiss the land, is when the magic unfolds and rain-sodden earth releases nature's most aromatic and invigorating scent, a faint incense rising upward. This scent with bergamot, patchouli, white floral and hints of musk captures the essence of the moment in a poetic and evocative way which serves as a sensory metaphor connecting to the city originally called Bom 'Bahia' meaning the Good bay.

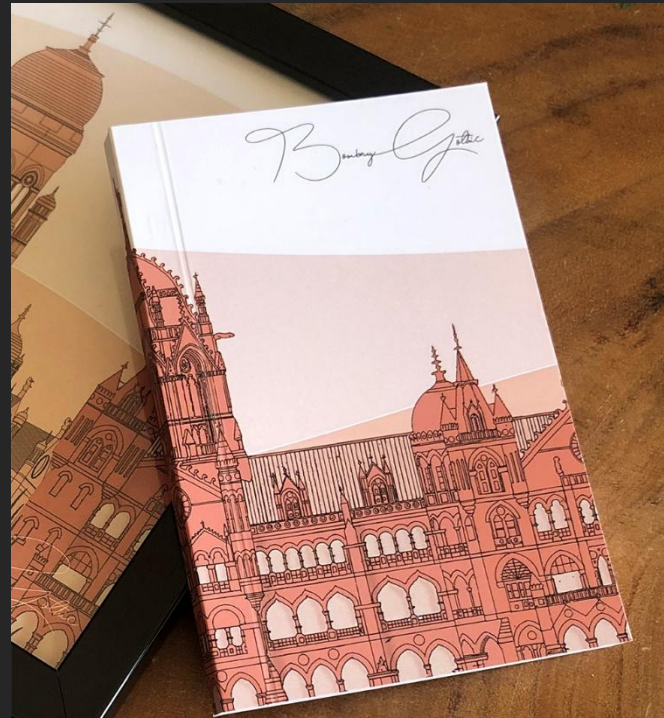
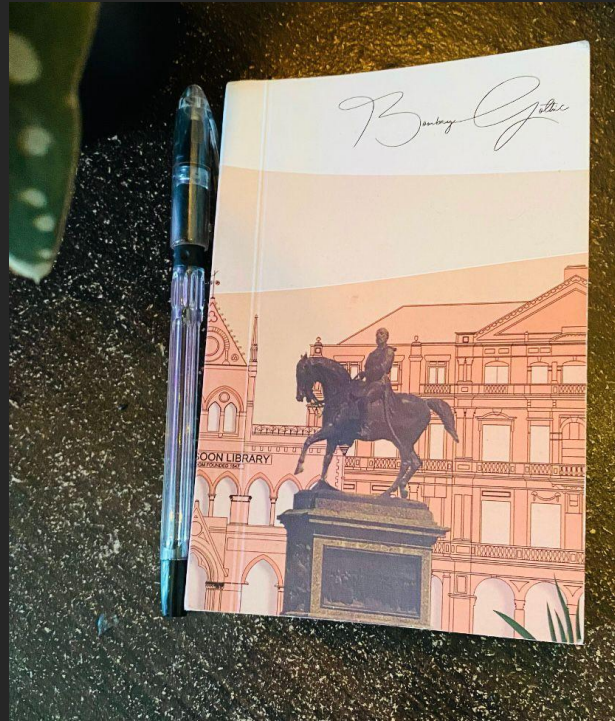

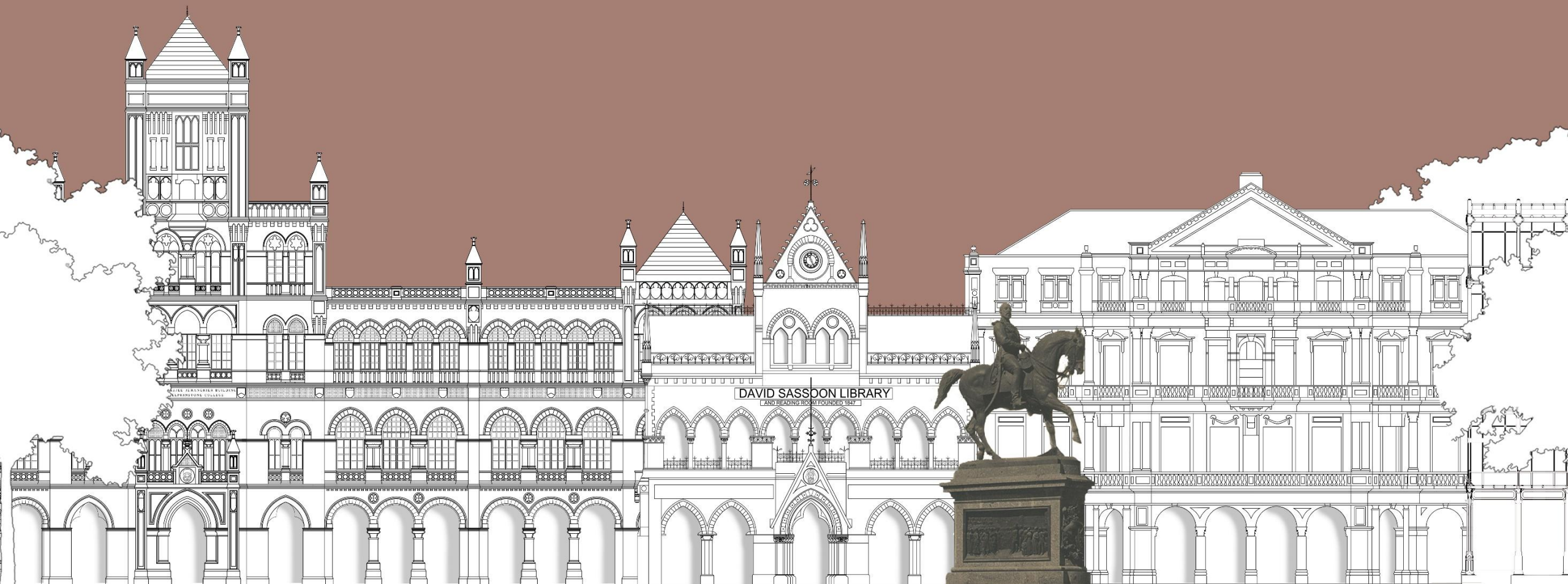
